



Donor's Giving Reflects *Believing*

"I truly believe in the Baptist Homes, and I can't let that go," says Gretchen Pallischeck, a former Board member, past president of the Women's Service Board, and long-time donor to FBH. "Not enough people know about the wonderful work Fairport Baptist Homes does for our aging population in the Rochester area, and I wanted to get the word out and really put FBH on the map!"

Gretchen's recent gift of over \$100,000 in memory of her late husband, Francis J. Pallischeck, to the Foundation's Endowment Fund, tips the current value of the Foundation's endowment (investment) account to just over \$2 million at the close of 2010. Just eight years ago this account stood at just over \$250,000.

Each year, the Foundation draws a percentage of the income from the endowment account to support the most pressing needs of the various ministries of Fairport Baptist Homes Caring Ministries.

At Gretchen's wish, the income from her gift will be used, in perpetuity, to support the needs of the skilled nursing facility, where her husband resided for two years prior to his death in 1985.

We spoke with Gretchen about her reasons for making this gift.

What is your background and connection with Fairport Baptist Homes?

"My husband had served on the FBH Board, but it wasn't until he became a resident at FBH that I first got involved as a volunteer with the Women's Service Board. I had a vested interest in the Home and I was so pleased with the care he received. I didn't fully understand

the value of FBH until my husband was on the receiving end. I wanted to learn the full story. Later I also served on the Board of Directors and as co-chair of the Hallways to Households Capital Campaign in the 1990's. I have been a volunteer in many ways for about 25 years."

What benefits do you think FBH provides to the community? What makes FBH special?

"I believe that the kind of loving care that FBH offers—care which encompasses not only the resident but also the whole family—is unique. FBH treats people like family and focuses primarily on the resident. Staff schedules are built around the resident's need instead of vice versa. They are always on the cutting edge of finding new and better ways to improve their services. The public isn't generally aware of all they do.

At FBH, people get more than their basic needs met; the staff add little touches, and the household model provides warmth. You can do things like have tea and cookies or family dinners in the household. That means so much.

I also like the fact that FBH does so many extra things that benefit the community such as the child care and now, the Tool Thrift Shop for the community. Seasons Child Care facility, right on the same campus, provides a way to blend the generations. Many families are separated by distance so that watching the little ones brings joy to older people, and the children are exposed to the aging. There is less time to dwell on one's aches and pains. As one resident expressed it, "I came here to live, not to die!"

Last December, the Foundation received notice of a very generous major gift from one of our longtime supporters, Gretchen Pallischeck. Her contribution to our Endowment Fund gives a boost to our efforts to support and enhance the important programs and services of FBH Caring Ministries. This is especially meaningful in light of continuing drastic funding cuts from New York State to nursing home operations across the state.



Each year, the Foundation draws from the earnings of its investment account to give funds back to the various operational ministries of FBH Caring Ministries, so that we can ensure that FBH is able to continue to offer the highest quality of care to our frail seniors.

As the Baby Boomer generation reaches 65 in the next year, we will need to focus more on finding viable options for supporting them as they age. These new programs and services, especially in their initial stages, will be expensive and may well fall outside of existing governmental support areas, thus requiring private support. financial support to help grow the Endowment Fund and ensure the long term programmatic and fiscal stability of FBH Caring Ministries.

The community also benefits. The shop 'Craft Bits and Pieces' in Fairport is a place where people can contribute the odds and ends of sewing (fabrics, yarn, tools, etc.) which are sold at reduced prices. The Tool Thrift Shop which recently opened also resells donated tools, even antique tools. The income from these business benefits FBH as well as the public.

FBH is definitely not just a nursing home. They always think of new ways they can help people, with little or no fanfare."

What are your general views about philanthropy and charitable giving?

"Both my husband and I struggled to get an education and have been blessed in so many ways that we felt a need to pass on these blessings so that others could benefit. It is important that everyone share with others in some way. There are many causes that deserve support.

I've tried to help my grandchildren experience the joy of giving to others. Once, I gave each of my nine grandchildren some money and asked that they give a portion of it to benefit someone else. They could use any amount in any way they chose. They didn't have to report back to me. There

was a new product on the market that fascinated one of them. I discovered that a granddaughter had given a Swiffer to the Ronald McDonald House. The bonus was that her family and I were given a tour of the place and we all learned about a most deserving charity. Another grandchild had contributed to a shelter for cats. They all had their own interests but they all experienced the joy and happiness of sharing."

What criteria influence your philanthropic decisions?

"I like to be sure that my gifts really benefit other people as well as the issues I care about. Sometimes it means getting involved to know how the gifts are being used. There are many worthwhile programs that deserve support and one has to be selective. Fairport Baptist Homes Caring Ministries is high on my list."

Tell us about the gift you have just made. What influenced this decision?

"I've always been a planner. For a long time I've wanted to make a special gift to FBH and I had some money invested for that purpose. At the same time, I realized that my younger sister who was in poor health needed help also. I was able to control the use of the earnings from

an investment, a charitable remainder trust, so I arranged to have the quarterly interest sent to my sister, who was very appreciative of this assistance. In turn, she gave 10% of this money to her own charitable interests! She felt good about this arrangement and so did I! I could have bequeathed this to her in my will, but there is only three years' difference in our ages—and who knew which of us would go first?

My sister passed way in November 2010. Now was the time to complete my gift to FBH. Many people have benefited. My planning had paid off."

What do you hope will be the lasting impact of this gift? What message would you like to convey to potential donors to Fairport Baptist Homes?

"I know the wonderful work that goes on at FBH. I also know that there are many people who need their services now and who will need them for years to come. God has given me many blessings and I feel good that I can be a blessing to others.

I'd like to inspire others to make their own planned gifts, either to FBH or to whatever organizations they care about. Planning is key! I have a zest for life and am glad that I've been able to plan ahead so that I can enjoy every day."
