# 2020 HIGHLIGHTS

A year like no other certainly had its challenges—and our loyal donors were there for us, as always! We truly couldn't do it without you, and are honored to know how much you support the work we do here at FBH, every day...

- Giving to our **Annual Appeal rose 26%**, from 10% more donors, over the prior year.
- **Donations to restricted funds** (e.g., gifts to benefit SOFI (Senior Options for Independence), Activities, and the Chapel) increased, while donations from area churches remained constant, with 83 faith communities from around the state continuing to support our work.

- Our 2020 “**Swing for Seniors**” golf tournament raised over \$50,000, even though we hosted half as many participants as usual, due to pandemic restrictions.
